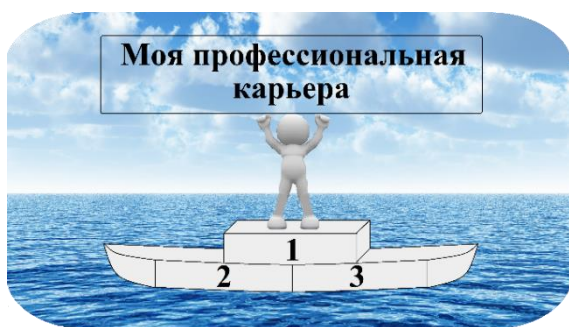

Название публикации: «DEVELOPING ENGLISH SPEAKING AND WRITING SKILLS»

Annotation: This article discusses the problems faced by many schoolchildren in speaking and writing in English in our country and ways to solve them effectively. A few thoughts on these issues are also recommended.

Keywords: English, speaking, writing, new pedagogical techniques, tips for learning English, games, movies, proverbs, translation.

It is well-known today that the teaching of foreign languages deserves special recognition in all regions of our country. An example of this is the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated December 10, 2012 PP 1875. The implementation of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "Ta'lim to'g'risida" and the National Program of Personnel Training in the country create a comprehensive system of teaching foreign languages aimed at forming a valuable, harmoniously developed, modern-minded young generation and also integration of the republic into the world community.

So the question is whether we, the foreign language teachers, understand these decisions and what we need to do, or whether we are still asleep, whether we have been able to strengthen our knowledge and make a radical change in the effectiveness of our work.

I would like to remind you that the purpose of writing this scientific article is to analyze the problems faced in my pedagogical activity and their methodological methods and to apply them in their practice as a methodological guide for all foreign language teachers. The problem is that we are working on the problems that many schoolchildren face in mastering English in Uzbekistan and how to solve them effectively.

All foreign language teachers know that teaching a foreign language requires a high level of knowledge and skills from a very specific teacher. A lot of students read and translate well from the book. Vocabulary is also well-formed. Grammatically, it is good, but I found out that the ability to speak is not developing. The thought of how to solve this problem kept me thinking. The only question was how to develop the same level of Reading, Writing Speaking and Listening. The many tried to learn in different ways and the result was gradually but not enough.

One day I came up with a new idea to develop speaking, and I decided to do that idea. This method is such that a learner translates independent texts and words from English into Uzbek, and depending on the translation. Then he/she rewrites the English text in English on the basis of the Uzbek translation.

Expected results are that if we first apply this method to pupils which are the 5th grade, we will see a number of mistakes. It is natural for some English words to be misspelled. This method will help us to eliminate these mistakes. We will have to explain that pupils do this exercise many times.

If you successfully pass this condition, you should know that your skill has mastered the same level of reading, writing, speaking and listening. These exercises can also be used by students in pairs. For example: One student speaks Uzbek, the second student translates the first student's thoughts directly into English. This is the play of the school's "Interview" game and the "Translator" game. Nowadays, there are many methodical games for the development of English speaking. Effective organization of these games also develops the level of English proficiency. For instance, it includes telling story, role-playing, and other interactive games.

It is no secret that the most reliable way to develop your knowledge of English speaking, language grammar, and any knowledge and skills related to English in general is to read and work diligently on yourself. But there are other ways to improve your English language skills. You can improve your English skills up to ten times. Here are some basic tips for learning English that will greatly help to learn English.

1. Watch or read a book or movie you have seen/read in English again.

For example, you may have read Alex Dumas's "Three Musketeers" in Uzbek, or you may have seen the Uzbek translation of Titanic. You know all the details of this book or movie. Why not try to find an English version of a book or movie now? Any movie or book can be found on the internet now. Try to enjoy the English version of your favorite work or movie.

2. Translate the book.

I know this is a very difficult task. However, it is worth a try. Initially, try to translate a small book which is written with simple words in English. You can present your successful translation to your acquaintances or internet users who knows English very well.

3. Read the dialogue book.

Conversations between two people can use a variety of phrases, idioms, and contextual terms. Reading such books will have a positive effect on the development of your speech. For those who do not know which book to read, you can use a simple book "English-Uzbek speaker".

4. Read an English comic book.

The good thing about reading comics is that you never get bored reading picture-rich, interesting stories. The story will be illustrates with pictures, so it will be easier to understand what is being said.

5. Learn English language games.

Some computer games of this type may seem too simple for you. But remember, the purpose of playing is not just to spend free time, You should learn English a little.

6. Increase reading English.

How many words can you read per minute? By practicing reading as much and as fast as you can, you can develop the ability to read fast in English.

7. Try to read without help.

Try to read large, complex text independently, without any dictionaries or other aids. Try to think of the meanings of unfamiliar words and phrases in the text.

8. Read books for children and adults.

Although books for English or American children are written in simple, easy-to-understand language, they may seem complicated enough for those who are just beginning to learn the language in Uzbekistan and whose mother tongue is not English. In any case, reading children's books will help you learn the language easily and learn to read at a simple stage.

9. Memorize proverbs in English.

There are many people who love proverbs and use them in every speech. In addition to our meaningful proverbs in Uzbek, you will also find proverbs in English. It is especially interesting to find and memorize English proverbs that correspond to the meaning of Uzbek folk proverbs.

10. Allocate space for English stickers on the wall of the room.

Fill an ever-visible part of your bedroom or classroom wall with a sticker (a piece of sticky paper) with English words on it. Try to stick as many words as possible. You can also remove the words you are sure you have memorized from the wall and then memorize all the words and clear the wall of scraps of sticky paper. In this case, memorization is a great exercise for you.
